It will be raffled off during the nights meeting.

Unfortunately, Septembers’ meeting had to be cancelled due to Hurricane Florence. Happy to report that there was minimal damage to the Chapter facilities.

Pioneer Campout will still be held 12-13 October. Please spread the word that the campout is still on. Participants must supply their own sleeping bag and tent.
